#### Oatmeal Bars with Jam

- 2 cups flour
- 1 cup old fashioned oatmeal
- 1 cup butter in small pieces
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1 ½ tsp cinnamon
- 1 1/3 cup jam or preserves of choice
- 1/3 cup oatmeal (for topping)

Lightly grease 9 x 13 baking pan. Line with parchment or foil for ease of removal and grease again.

Preheat oven to 325 degrees

In food processor, put flour, oatmeal, butter pieces, brown sugar and cinnamon. Pulse until all ingredients are combined. Set one cup aside.

Pour remaining flour mixture into prepared pan. Even out and pat down gently.

Spread jam over flour mixture.

Add the 1/3 cup oatmeal to the reserved flour mixture and sprinkle mixture evenly over jam. Gently pat down to adhere mixture to jam.

Bake 40-45 minutes.

DO NOT UNDERCOOK OR BOTTOM CRUST WILL BE SOFT.
